2023 SPRING C.E.R.T. TRAINING CLASSES

The spring C.E.R.T. (Community Emergency Response Training) Classes are scheduled to begin in MARCH. This training is provided to all Willard area residents as a public service by Willard City and Willard Fire Department. These classes are designed to help all Citizens become better prepared for all types of emergency or disaster situations.

Training sessions range from PERSONAL PREPAREDNESS to a wide variety of FAMILY, NEIGHBORHOOD and COMMUNITY readiness. We encourage every household to have at least one CERT trained family member.

All classes are held at Willard City Office Building, 80 West 50 South.

The cost is \$10 per person. Classes will be offered in-person only this year.

Code Red is a notification system that uses various means to get important emergency alerts and notifications out to members of the community. Box Elder County now has this system in place. The system will send out calls to local Area Code 435 listed land lines. The Code Red system can call/text other Area Code numbers if the number(s) has been registered. Click on the Code Red logo (shown) on the Willard City Website page (willardcity.com) to register your cell phone and/or additional numbers. An App is available for smartphones. Check your cell phone App Store to download the free Code Red app. Check out the FAQ sheet link on the City website for additional information. Contact the City Office if you have questions.

Willard City Suggested Operating Procedures for Community Wide Emergency/Disaster Communication Efforts

To Establish Communications:

❖ Turn FRS/GMRS Radio to assigned Neighborhood Main Channel and Sub-Channel (If this has been established)

If Not – Use Channel 9 Sub-Channel 11 (CERT Channel)

❖ HAM Radio to Simplex 146.440

(Willard Stake: Simplex 145.700/145.640)



❖ Local AM Radio Station 1620 (Continuous Broadcast – tune in now to listen)

If you are registered with CodeRED you will receive emergency information and instructions
