Snow season is approaching. Please pay attention to weather forecasts. Remove trailers, vehicles, landscaping rocks, debris piles, etc. from road sides to allow snow to be pushed as far off the asphalt as possible.



## DEPARTMENTS

**Fire** – Residential open burn permits may be issued by the Box Elder County Fire Marshal between September 15 and October 30. You must call 435-734-3345 to get a permit.

**Public Works** – Water meters are the property of the City. If you are installing a sprinkler system or need the water turned off at the meter for any reason, contact the City Office at 435-734-9881, or Dispatch at 435-734-3800 for after-hour emergencies. This avoids costly damage to the meter itself. As temperatures begin to fall be sure to properly winterize sprinkling systems to avoid broken lines and costly leaks. As the snow flies, please make sure meters are accessible in case of an emergency Also, pay attention to the usage on your water bill. Compare your usage from month to month
