- ❖ **911 What's your emergency?** Please do not call the City Office if you need a Police Officer or the Fire Department. Call Box Elder County Dispatch at 435-734-3800 or 911 if it is an emergency. This is important for the safety of emergency responders and also provides a quicker response especially in an emergency.

- ❖ **Snow Removal** - It's that time of year when snow can hit. Please remove vehicles, garbage cans (as soon as possible) and debris on the city right-of-way. This will help avoid damage to property and allow for faster removal of snow on the city streets.
- ❖ **Avoid Frozen Water Lines** – To avoid frozen waterlines, you may want to leave a tap at a slow drip. Also be sure and check your water usage on your bill. Average water usage for winter months is between 5,000 and 15,000 gallons. More than that could be an indication of a leak.
- ❖ **Dog Licensing** –Dog licenses are now past due and a \$5.00 late fee has been added.
- ❖ **Business Licenses** –Business licenses expired on December 31, 2014. Please renew them now. Business licenses are required for anyone doing business within the Willard City limits. If you have any questions, contact the City Offices at 435-734-9881.
- ❖ **Willard Dike Area** – Please be considerate of those who are using the trail system by cleaning up after your pets and not littering. Paintballing is not be allowed anywhere in the dike area.
- ❖ **Stop Signs** – Please be cautious when approaching intersections where you know there have been stop signs. The maintenance personnel have noticed several around town that have been removed or pushed over. If you notice a sign is missing or laying on the ground contact the Willard City Offices at 435-734-9881.

## Police Department

## 2015 Municipal Elections

Willard City will be holding a Municipal Election on November 3, 2015. Positions available are: (3) City Council Positions - each are 4 year terms. Declarations of Candidacy will be accepted beginning June 1, 2015.

### 20A-9-203. Declarations of candidacy -- Municipal general elections.

- (1)(a)(i) A person may become a candidate for any municipal office if:
- (A) the person is a registered voter; and
  - (B)(I) the person has resided within the municipality in which that person seeks to hold elective office for the 12 consecutive months immediately before the date of the election; or
  - (II) if the territory in which the person resides was annexed into the municipality, the person has resided within the annexed territory or the municipality the 12 consecutive months immediately before the date of the election.
- (ii) For purposes of determining whether a person meets the residency requirement of Subsection (1)(a)(i)(B)(I) in a municipality that was incorporated less than 12 months before the election, the municipality shall be considered to have been incorporated 12 months before the date of the election.
- (b) In addition to the requirements of Subsection (1)(a), each candidate for a municipal council position shall, if elected from a district, be a resident of the council district from which elected.
- (c) In accordance with Utah Constitution Article IV, Section 6, any mentally incompetent person, any person convicted of a felony, or any person convicted of treason or a crime against the elective franchise may not hold office in this state until the right to hold elective office is restored under Section 20A-2-101.3 or 20A-2-101.5.

Declarations of Candidacy must be filed in person with the City Recorder during office hours 8 am to 5 pm, June 1, 2015, through June 8, 2015.
