Dog Licensing – Dog licenses are now overdue and a \$5.00 late fee is now added to the cost of the license. Owners for dogs licensed in 2017 were sent a postcard in November. Please contact us if you no longer have your dog or dog has passed away so it can be removed from our list. A reminder all dogs are required to be licensed and the maximum allowed per household is 3. Please provide proof of current rabies vaccinations if it is indicated on the postcard it is required.



Business Licenses -Business licenses also expired on December 31, 2017. There were some changes in the 2017 State Legislative session regarding home businesses. Reminders were sent to 2017 licensed business owners who are required to renew their license. If you have any questions, contact the City Offices at 734-9881.

❖ **Streets and Water-** We haven't had much snow or cold temps. If they make a late arrival here are some important reminders.

- **Streets** – Remember last year? We all were running out of places to put the snow. This year we have not had much in the way of snowfall. This is good on our backs because we don't have to shovel, but provides a dismal water outlook. This is a reminder not to shovel the snow from your driveway into the street. It creates a frozen pile that damages to the snow plows. It is also against the City Ordinances and you could be cited for it. Also make sure vehicles are off the pavement at least 2 ft.



- **Water** – A reminder to keep water meters accessible in case of an emergency.
- **Sewer-** Property owners are responsible for the sewer clean outs and line to where it hooks into the main line. Be sure to watch what you put down your toilet and drains to avoid costly

Report any suspicious activity in your neighborhoods by calling Dispatch at 435-734-3800 for non-emergencies or call 911 if it is an emergency.



CERT Training:

CERT - It's never too early to plan for emergencies, but it is all too often too late. CERT Classes are scheduled to begin March. This will be the full training. The dates for classes are March 6th, 8th, 10th, 13th, 15th and 17th. Weekday classes are from 6:00 pm - 9:30 pm and Saturday classes are from 8:00 am - 4:00 pm. This is great information to help your family become prepared when an emergency hits. An emergency can be as little as the power being out for more than a couple of hours (LIKE A COUPLE OF WEEKS AGO!) or the water turned off because of a line break to a major disaster such as an earthquake.
