The snow season is upon us. Please help the snow plow drivers by moving vehicles, trailers, and garbage cans from the sides of the roads when it snows or if there is a chance of snow overnight. The Public Works employees have had a few close calls with vehicles parked in the City right-of-way. Vehicles that continue to be a problem will be towed at the owner's expense. Do not shovel snow into the plowed roads. Please place it along side the road and please clear the snow from around your mailbox so the postal carriers can deliver your mail.



DOG LICENSES - All dog licenses expired on December 31, 2013, and will become delinquent January 31, 2014. **All** dogs are required to be licensed. The licenses are available at the City offices. The cost is \$5.00 for dogs that are spayed or neutered and \$15.00 for those that are not. Proof of current rabies vaccination is also required. Rabies vaccinations are required every two years. **See the reminder for the Rabies Clinic on the back of the newsletter!**



BUSINESS LICENSES - Business licenses also expired on December 31, 2013. Business licenses are required for anyone doing business within the Willard City limits. Costs are based on the type of business you have and those business owners of businesses licensed last year have been sent a reminder in the mail. If you have any questions, contact the City Office.

If the temperature is below freezing for an extended period of time you may want to consider leaving an inside tap dripping to prevent frozen water lines.

RADON AWARENESS EVENT - PERRY CITY

INDOOR RADON - Approximately 20,000 lung cancer deaths each year in the U.S. are radon-related. Exposure to radon is the second leading cause of lung cancer after smoking. (EPA estimate) Radon is an odorless, tasteless and invisible gas produced by the decay of naturally occurring uranium in soil and water. Why is radon the public health risk that it is? How does a person test for radon in their home? What can be done to fix a house that has elevated radon levels? Come to a Town Hall Meeting to get answers to these and other questions about the dangers of indoor radon.
