Police Officer

The Willard City Police department is accepting applications for a PART TIME Police Officer (20 hours per week). The selection steps may include a written test, oral interviews, and a physical fitness test. The successful candidate must pass a stringent background check and pre-employment drug screening. Pay is dependent upon qualifications.

Qualifications: Applicants must be 21 years of age or older at the time of employment and possess Utah P.O.S.T Law Enforcement Officer (LEO) certification in good standing or be certifiable prior to date of employment. Applicants must possess a valid Utah driver's license or have the ability to obtain one prior to employment. Applicants who are currently serving as Police Officers may be given preference in the testing process. Applicants should be able to demonstrate knowledge of community-oriented policing, patrol operations, criminal investigations, report writing, and safety standards related to the use of vehicles, firearms, and other police equipment.

Physical Demands and Work Environment – Willard City Police Officers require a variety of physical activities periodically involving muscular strain related to walking, standing, stooping, sitting and reaching. Mental application utilizes memory for details, emotional stability, discriminating thinking and creative problem-solving. Frequent travel required in course of performing portions of job functions. While performing the duties of this job, police officers work in outside weather conditions. Police officers work rotating shifts, on weekends and on holidays.
