It didn't take long for all that green grass to turn brown! Wildfire season is already in full swing with a number of them burning across the state. The City Council passed a Special Ordinance to put fire and fireworks restrictions in place for everything East of Highway 89 until September 15, 2020. Legal fireworks, in allowed areas, can be used from the period 2 days before and 1 day after the 4<sup>th</sup> and 24<sup>th</sup> of July.

**COVID-19 UPDATE**

On May 16, 2020 Box Elder County and most of Utah transitioned to the Yellow Phase of the Utah Leads Together Plan. On June 1, 2020 Box Elder County had 29 confirmed cases. As we are approaching July 1, 2020 Box Elder is nearing the 150 case mark. (<https://brhd.org/coronavirus/>) Cases are also hitting closer to home.

We ask residents to help curb the upward trend and follow the recommended guidelines including wearing face masks out in public. Governor Herbert is scheduled to look at the statistics and make some critical decisions on July 10.

## Departments

- **Streets.** Please clear debris from the sides of the roads to allow for summer maintenance.
- **Water** – Protect our water system. Do you know putting a hose in a pool and then shutting it off without taking it out of the pool can contaminate drinking water? Planning on putting in a sprinkler system? Doing outside watering? Visit our website [www.willardcity.com](http://www.willardcity.com) for valuable information on how to avoid cross connection and for important backflow prevention information. - **Sewer-** Property owners are responsible for the sewer line from your home to the main line. Make sure sewer cleanouts are cut off at ground level and capped or protected to avoid debris from causing costly back-ups into your house and breaking off.

## Police

- **Dogs: All dogs** over 6 months of age are required to be licensed. To license your dog we need proof of rabies vaccinations and proof of spay or neutering if they have been. Willard City allows 3 dogs maximum per residence.
- **Parks** If you take your dogs for a walk to the park, including the Nature Park or along the streets to “do their business” please do your part and clean up after them. Let’s keep Willard beautiful!
- **Lock your Vehicles** – There are still reports of items being taken from vehicles. There has also been an increase in trailer thefts along the Wasatch Front please take the time to put locks on trailers. Report any suspicious activity as soon as possible.
