**Police Department**

Summer is here!!! The warmer weather typically brings an increase in theft reports. Please take the extra time to lock all vehicle doors, this includes travel trailers, and your homes when leaving, even for a short period of time. Also, make sure to shut garage doors when leaving. Do not leave anything of value where it is visible to someone standing outside your vehicle such as cell phones, wallets, purses, guns etc.



If you have an emergency DO NOT contact the Willard City Offices, call **911**. Trained dispatchers will dispatch the Fire Department or Police Department and will give additional information to those responding that the City Offices cannot. To help those responding to an emergency please make sure your address is visible from the street. If you do not have an address on your house it could be a matter of life or death when emergency personnel are responding.



**Willard Irrigation**

A reminder for irrigation water users. You are responsible for keeping irrigation water contained to your own property and not let it run off onto city streets. If you have problems contact the ditch master listed on your schedule.

**Door to door Solicitors**

Door to door solicitors are required to have a business license through Willard City. If they cannot produce a

**No Dumping**
