

Willard Cemetery staff requests that visitors please refrain from unnecessary dumping of anything except dry flowers from decorated graves. In the past it seems more respect was practiced at the sacred grounds; but times have changed, and even outside visitors think it acceptable to dispose of plastic & glass drinking cups, household garbage, etc. in containers meant for grounds cleanup. Even an air conditioner, bicycles and a microwave were thrown on the cemetery burn pile, which is meant for tree trimmings. It is not a public dump.

We regret the need to limit access to refuse containers; however, as many other cemeteries do, we ask visitors to be vigilant in disposing of anything other than burnable decorations. Please take personal trash home with you. Thank you.
