We recently experienced the first snowfall of the season. For the safety of city maintenance personnel and to avoid damage to your personal property, residents are reminded to remove any vehicles and trailers that are in the City right-of-way. Also, remove garbage cans



from the road as soon as possible after garbage is picked up. For other motorists safety do not shovel snow from your driveway into the road. Willard City Ordinance Chapter 10-340 (B) states "It is unlawful to park a vehicle on a street at any time when such parking shall interfere with the City's efforts to remove snow from City streets or any other public works activities which require the removal of vehicles from the street." 
<u>Dog Licenses</u> - All dog licenses expired on December 31, 2012, and will become delinquent January 31, 2013. <u>All</u> dogs are required to be licensed. The licenses are available at the City offices. The cost is \$5.00 for dogs that are spayed or

neutered and \$15.00 for those that are not. Proof of current rabies vaccination is also required. Rabies vaccinations are required every two years. See the reminder for the Rabies Clinic on the back of the newsletter!

<u>Business Licenses</u> - Business licenses also expired on December 31, 2012. Business licenses are required for anyone doing business within the Willard City limits. Costs are based on the type of business you have and those business owners of businesses licensed last year have been sent a reminder in the mail. If you have any questions, contact the City Office.


Water
