Police Department

Summer is here!!! The warmer weather typically brings an increase in theft reports. There have been reports of stolen gas on the east side of town. Please take the extra time to lock all vehicle doors, this includes travel trailers, and your homes when leaving, even for a short period of time. Also, make sure to shut garage doors when leaving. Do not leave anything of value where it is visible to someone standing outside your vehicle such as cell phones, wallets, purses, guns etc.

If you have an emergency DO NOT contact the Willard City Offices, call **911**. Trained dispatchers will dispatch the Fire Department or Police Department and will give additional information to those responding that the City Offices cannot. To help those responding to an emergency please make sure your address is visible from the street. If you do not have an address on your house it could be a matter of life or death when emergency personnel are responding.



Elections

The Municipal General Election will be held on November 5, 2013. The offices to be voted on are Mayor - 4 year term and (2) City Council Member positions 4 year term each. Filing must be done in person or by petition. The filing period will be June 3, 2013 -June 7, 2013, during office hours - 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. Please contact the city office if you have any questions at 435-734-9881.
