Burn Permit

Before you burn your spring trimmings you must first obtain a burn permit. There is no cost for the permit and they are available by calling Box Elder Communications at 435-734-3833. They are available on days with good air quality and fires must be extinguished by dark. If you are planning on burning on Saturday you will need to call on Friday to obtain the permit. Outdoor burning is prohibited in Box Elder County on Sunday and Monday.
