Elections

The Municipal General Election will be held on November 5, 2013. The offices to be voted on are Mayor - 4 year term and (2) City Council Member positions 4 year term each. Filing must be done in person or by petition. The filing period will be June 3, 2013 -June 7, 2013, during office hours - 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. The qualifications for candidacy are:

1. Be a United States citizen at the time of filing.
2. Be a registered voter of the municipality;
3. Be a resident of the municipality for 12 consecutive months immediately preceding the date of the election;
4. Cannot be a convicted felon.
