Spay and Neuter Clinic

The Cache Valley Humane Society will be holding a low-cost spay/neuter clinic Wednesday November 13th. They will meet pet owners at 7:00 am at the Willard LDS Building parking lot located at 80 North 100 West, and will transport the animals to the Cache Valley Humane Center. They will notify the pet owners when they are ready to transport them back in the afternoon. All animals must be in carriers for departure. If you do not have a carrier or your animal does not travel well,



please inform CHS when making the appointment.

Cost for dogs: Spay \$60.00, Neuter \$50.00 and dogs over 75lbs are \$1.00 per pound.

Cost for cats: Spay \$45.00, Neuter \$35.00.

Additional fees for pain medication, pregnant, in heat, cryptorchid, and collars. If you can not afford the fees call and talk to them. Appointments are required call 435-792-3920 to schedule or for questions.

Fire Department

Want to burn those fall leaves? Remember to call the Box Elder County Fire Marshall's Office at 734-3833 to get a burn permit. If you are planning to burn on **Saturday**, you will need to call **Friday** for the permit. No burn permits will be issued for Sundays or Mondays. Burn permits will be issued on days with correct weather conditions and air quality. Citations will be issued if you are caught burning without a permit. Burn safely!



Streets Department

It won't be long until the beautiful red and yellow leaves are gone and the snow begins to fly. The Willard City Maintenance crew requests residents clean debris off of the city right-of-way and move vehicles and trailers from city streets for snow removal. Please do not push snow from driveways and walks into the streets as it freezes and creates hazardous conditions for motorists. Also, please remove garbage cans from the road as soon as possible after a snow storm.



Residents are also requested to keep the meter clear of snow and other materials in case an emergency arises and the meter needs to be turned off.

Sewer/Water/Garbage

The utility bill this month includes the recent increase in sewer fees. The new sewer fee is \$59.50, passed during the October 10, 2013 City Council meeting. The Mayor and City Council members have committed to look for every opportunity to provide additional income for the Sewer Department.

For your convenience, a payment drop box is located on the west side of the Willard City Offices. Willard City Office hours are 9:00 am to 5:00 pm, Monday - Friday. **Utility bills are sent out the 5th of each month and are due by the 20th of each month. Payments received after the 25th are subject to \$5.00 in late charges.**
