Don't forget to make sure you are registered to vote. If you have not registered you can do so on the State of Utah website at www.utah.gov and search for voter registration. The deadline to register in person at the Box Elder County Clerk's office at 01 S. Main in Brigham City is October 21, 2013.. Not sure if you are registered? You can give them a call at 435-734-3393. Early voting will be held from Tuesday, October 22 through Friday, November 1 at the Willard City Offices. The Willard City General Municipal Election will be held on November 5, 2013.

Fire Prevention Week is October 6th thru 12th

October is Fire Prevention month. Willard Fire Fighters will be teaching elementary students about fire safety in the home. This is a good time for all residents to check smoke detectors, replace the batteries and check fire extinguishers. Also take time to identify and practice escape routes. It is also recommended residents prepare 72 hour kits and have an emergency folder with copies of important documents that is readily available in case you are required to leave your home in any emergency situation.



Fire Dept. Open House

The Willard Fire Department invites all residents to an open house to be held on October 22, 2013 from 6:00-8:00 p.m. Residents are encouraged to take this opportunity to meet the fire fighters, learn about what they do and learn important fire safety tips. Residents will also be able to see the fire and rescue trucks and the other equipment they



use.

Police Department

Chief Thompson is asking residents if they have put "No Parking" signs in front of their residences to please remove them. It is not illegal to park on the city right of ways and only signs approved and put up by the City will be enforced. He would also like to remind residents keep cars locked, and to take valuable items out of the vehicle at night or keep them out of view. Also, keep garages, sheds, cars and doors locked.



Sewer

As reported in the news, popular pre-moistened bathroom wipes often advertised as flush-able are being blamed for sewer clogs and backups in sewer systems. Wastewater authorities say wipes may go down the toilet ok but do not break down as they course through the system. Please be mindful of what you put through the sewer system.

Streets

Willard City Maintenance Personnel have asked citizens to clear branches, yard waste, piles of rocks and dirt from the edge of the city right of ways. This will help them be able to maintain the edge of the streets.
