## ❖ Willard Municipal Election Canceled

Pursuant to Utah Code 20 A-1-206: A municipal legislative body may cancel an election if: all the municipal officers are elected in an at-large election; and the number of municipal officer candidates, including any eligible write-in candidates, if any, does not exceed the number of open at-large municipal offices for which the candidates have filed.

On September 10, 2015, the Willard City Council adopted Resolution 2015-16 canceling the Willard City November 3, 2015, Municipal Election and certifying the following:

- There are three candidates for three at-large City Council member positions.
- There are no municipal ballot propositions.
- The following candidates are considered to be elected to office:

❖ **October is Fire Prevention month!** – The Willard City Fire Department will be holding an open house on October 20, 2015 from 6pm-8pm at the Willard City Fire Station 95 W 50 N. Come and visit with the great volunteer firefighters and learn of ways to protect your home and family. **DON'T FORGET TO CHECK YOUR SMOKE DETECTORS!**

❖ **Burn Permits** - NO BURN PERMITS WILL BE ISSUED UNLESS THE CLEARING INDEX IS ABOVE 500 for Airshed 4. Links to check the index are available at [www.willardcity.com](http://www.willardcity.com). The Division of Air Quality regulates this, not the County Fire Marshal. If the Burn Index is not above 500 on the day you want to burn do not call for a burn permit.

- **Agricultural Burn Permits** - Agriculture burning falls into a little different category and permits can be issued year round, ONLY if the Clearing Index is above 500 for Airshed 4. In order to qualify for an agriculture burn permit, you must be burning natural vegetation, ie: fruit tree pruning, ditch banks and stubble fields, you must be farming as a livelihood, and your property must be in the greenbelt for taxes. If you meet the criteria for Agricultural Burn Permits and the Clearing Index is above 500 for Airshed 4 call 435-734-3345. Burn Permits for Saturday will be issued on Friday and there is no burning on Sunday.
- **Residential Burn Permits** - The "Residential Burn Windows" are March 30- May 30 and September 15- October 30. Burn permits can ONLY BE ISSUED IF THE Clearing Index is above 500 for Airshed 4. State requirements limit burning for only natural vegetation, ie: tree trimmings, leaves, etc., can be burned. This means no construction debris, household garbage, tires, etc. can be burned. Other methods of disposal will need to be used for these items. If the date is between the Residential Burn windows and the index is above 500 for Airshed 4 call 435-734-3345. Burn Permits for Saturday will be issued on Friday but you will have to check the Clearing Index before you start burning on Saturday and there is no burning on Sunday.

#### **Police Department**

❖ A bicycle is a vehicle and you're the driver and are expected to follow the same rules of the road. When you ride in the street, obey all traffic (stop) signs, yield (wait) for traffic. If there is no stop sign and you are coming from a smaller roadway (out of a driveway, from a sidewalk, a bike path, etc.), you must slow down and look to see if the way is clear before proceeding. When turning left or right, always look behind you then make the turn.
