SCAM ALERT!!!!



Residents are reporting phone calls from the IRS, credit card companies, and many others. Many even have some information about the person they are calling.

Callers are becoming more and more demanding and threatening arrest or harm to loved ones. Hang up!!! Call dispatch for a police officer to follow up at 435-734-3800. **DO NOT** give personal information over the phone unless you have made the phone call to a number you trust (not one returned to a message left on your phone!) Also be aware of emails that appear to be from credit card companies, banks, email providers, etc. asking for updated information or even confirming changes to your account and asking you to click on a link. They are most likely scams.

DEPARTMENTS

❖ Streets, Sewer, and Water-

- **Streets** - The snow season is coming upon us. Please pay attention to weather forecasts and remove trailers and vehicles from the sides of the roads to allow the snow to be pushed as far off the asphalt as possible.
- **Sewer**- Property owners are responsible for the sewer line from the home to the main line. This means you need to be careful of what goes down the drain. Backups are costly! Also, make sure sewer cleanouts are cut off at ground level and capped or protected to avoid breaking them off and debris falling into the line which can also cause back-ups.
- **Water** – Water meters are the property of the City. If you are installing sprinkler systems or need the water turned off at the meter for any reason contact the City Office at 435-734-9881 or Dispatch 435-734-3800 for after-hours emergencies to have Water Department Personnel turn it off. This is to avoid costly damage to the meter itself. As the snow flies please make sure our meters are accessible in case of an emergency. As temperatures begin to fall be sure to properly winterize sprinkling systems to avoid broken lines and costly leaks. Also, pay attention to the usage on your water bill. Get a good idea of what your average usage is and compare it from month to month!
- **City Parks –PLEASE - PLEASE - PLEASE CLEAN UP AFTER YOUR DOGS!**

- ❖ **Burn Permits** – The Fall open burn period is from September 15 – October 30. Extremely dry conditions still exist, but rain may be heading our way! **NO BURN PERMITS WILL BE ISSUED UNLESS THE CLEARING INDEX IS ABOVE 500 for Airshed 4.** Links to check the index are available at www.willardcity.com or by calling the Box Elder County Fire Marshal at 435-734-3345. The Division of Air Quality regulates this, not the County Fire Marshal. If the Burn Index is not above 500 on the day you want to burn do not call for a burn permit.



❖ Police

- **VEHICLE THEFTS** – There has been a number of vehicle burglaries on the east side of town. **PLEASE DO NOT** leave your keys in the car or your vehicles unlocked. Put items away. Lock garages, storage sheds. Don't leave purses, bags, electronics, coins, personal information in your vehicle and if you do, don't leave them in plain view. Please report any suspicious activity in your neighborhood as soon as you notice it! The number to Box Elder County Dispatch is 435-734-3800 Option (0) for non-emergency calls. If it is an emergency call 911.
- **DOGS** – If you are a dog owner, license your dog, keep them on a leash when walking them, control barking- especially at night and clean up after them if they “do their business” anywhere that is not in your yard!
