

OFFICIAL NOTICE MUNICIPAL GENERAL ELECTION
September 14, 2021

I, Michelle K. Vest Snarr, hereby give notice of the Municipal General Election that will be held on Tuesday, November 2, 2021.

Voters must be citizens of the United States; be a registered voter; be residents of Willard City; and 18 years old, or older by the General Election in order to participate. If you are not a registered voter you can register to vote up **until 5:00 p.m. on October 22, 2021**, at the Box Elder County Clerk's Office at 1 South Main Street, Suite 110, Brigham City, UT. You may also register to vote or update your registration by visiting vote.utah.gov – note: voter registration must be received by the County Clerk's Office no later than 5:00 p.m. on October 22, 2021.

A sample ballot for the General Election may be obtained from the City website, willardcity.com/elections/html or in person at Willard City Hall, 80 West 50 South, Willard, Utah.

A public demonstration will be held to test the voting devices and tabulation equipment being used for the election. Anyone desiring to witness the testing is invited to attend, beginning at 8:30 a.m. October 7, 2021, at the Box Elder County Clerk's Office – 1 South Main Street, Suite 100, Brigham City, Utah.

The Box Elder County Clerk's Office will mail out ballots on October 12, 2021. Willard City will have a ballot drop box inside the city offices from October 12, 2021, through November 2, 2021. In addition, on Election Day, the city offices will be open from 7:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. for a voter to return their ballot or vote in person. ***A person who is not registered to vote, may register to vote, and vote on election day by voting a provisional ballot (UCA 20A-2-207).***

As required by the Lieutenant Governor's Election Policy, an audit of the election will be conducted on November 8, 2021, starting at 8:00 a.m. Anyone desiring to witness the audit is invited to attend. The audit will be conducted at the Box Elder Clerk's Office – 1 South Main Street, Suite 100, Brigham City, Utah.
