## NORTH MARINA TO US-89

### PROJECT INFORMATION

The Utah Department of Transportation (UDOT) is conducting a maintenance project to improve conditions on approximately one mile of SR-315 from the Marina at Willard Bay to US-89, in south Box Elder County. The project includes mill and overlay, asphalt paving, chip seal, shoulder work, striping, and signage.

Construction is scheduled to begin on August 3, and will continue to August 28, 2020. Construction will occur from 7:00 am to 7:00 pm, Monday through Friday.

Although speed limits may be reduced in the corridor by the use of a pilot car, the only actual speed reduction that will take place is when the speed limit is dropped to 40 mph for chip seal operations and associated cure times.

Crews will work to minimize impacts to local residents, businesses and the traveling public

whenever possible. No road closures will occur during construction; however, flaggers will control traffic. Expect 10 minute delays while work is occurring.

Please use extreme caution at the railroad crossing adjacent to the Flying J Travel Center as we will be using flagger(s), and traffic will not always be in the natural lane or protected by activated railroad crossing warning systems.
