MAYOR'S COMMENTS

In April of 2024, Willard completed an update to our General Plan (see the Willard City web page). The plan had good public participation. It includes five areas that will provide over 1,000 homes ranging from multi-family to 1/3 of an acre. The vast majority of participating residents wanted to preserve areas of Willard in 1/2 acre or greater lots. That is also reflected in the plan. Developers and new residents need to do their due diligence and review the General Plan before they commit and purchase property in any community. Developers and residents should also have a reasonable expectation that the leaders of the city will be guided by that plan. Every three to five years, we need to review the plan and adjust it if it is not meeting the goals of the citizenry. Multiple sections of Willard's code require that we follow our General Plan. It is important that we are not swayed to governance by emotion. Willard is a great community. It is important that we continue to thoughtfully plan and follow our ordinances.

DEPARTMENTS

POLICE – Willard City requires all door-to-door salespeople to be licensed. If they are licensed, they should be wearing a city-issued ID. If a door-to-door salesperson does not have a city-issued ID, please close the door and call dispatch at 435-734-3800 Option 0. There is always an increase in reported scams this time of year. **DO NOT** give out personal information over the phone to anyone who calls or leaves a message. Beware of phishing emails. **DO NOT** send personal information by email or click on links in an email, even if they appear to come from a friend.

FIRE – Residential open burn permits may be issued between March 30 and May 30 by Box Elder County Fire. Burn permits must be obtained before any burning. Not obtaining a permit may result in a fine. Call 435-734-3345 to get a permit. Permits are only issued from 9:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. Burn permits are issued on Friday for Saturday, and there is no burning on Sundays. Burns must be attended at all times, have a hose nearby, and must be out by dark. No burning is allowed before 10:00 a.m. Materials to be burned must be thoroughly dry. No trash, rubbish, tires, or oil can be burned or used to start fires or keep fires burning. State law prohibits burning trash in burn barrels. Agricultural burns are allowed year-round as long as the property is in the greenbelt. Ditch banks, grasses, tree trimmings, and natural vegetation are considered natural.

PUBLIC WORKS – Spring means Public Works will be changing, locating, and reading water meters. Please make sure that nothing is covering your meter boxes. Public Works can remove obstructions at the owner's expense.

Park restrooms will be opened around the 15th of April.

Please remember that water conservation is important. While It seems this year is shaping up to be an average water year, we don't know what the coming years will bring us. We want to maximize our water supply to help us through future years.

Please help protect our water system. Don't leave a hose in a pool. It can contaminate drinking water. If you plan to put in a sprinkling system, you can find information about backflow prevention and avoiding cross connections at www.utah.gov/drinking-water/cross-connection-control-backflow-prevention.
