NOTICE OF 2017 MUNICIPAL PRIMARY ELECTION AND EARLY VOTING

Willard City will hold a Municipal Primary Election on Tuesday August 15, 2017. The polling place is located at the Willard City Office - 80 West 50 South, Willard, UT and will be open from 7:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m.

Early voting will begin on Tuesday, August 1, 2017, at the Willard City Office 80 West 50 South and will continue through Friday, August 11, 2017. The hours for early voting are 9 am - 5 pm. All voters must show a valid photo identification.

The public logic & accuracy testing for the electronic voting machines will be held on Friday, July 28, 2017, at 8:00 am. in Room 10 of the Box Elder County Courthouse, 01 S Main, Brigham City, UT. Any changes to the polling location will be posted on Willard City's website at www.willardcity.com. DEPARTMENTS

❖ Streets, Sewer, and Water-

- **Streets** - Please keep the City right-of-way clear of debris such as yard decorations, rocks, piles of limbs and yard debris, or landscaping or construction materials to name a few.
- **Sewer**- Property owners are responsible for the sewer line from the home to the main line. This means you need to be careful of what goes down the drain. Backups are costly! Also, make sure sewer cleanouts are cut off at ground level and capped or protected to avoid breaking them off and debris falling into the line which can also cause back-ups.

NO NEEDLES PLEASE!!!!!!!

The Wastewater Treatment Facility Board has requested we send out notice to residents **NOT** to dispose of needles by flushing them down the toilet. This creates a dangerous situation for the Wastewater Treatment Plant operators. The following are guidelines for safe household disposal:

Safe Needle Disposal Resources for Utah

In the state of Utah, there is a community sharps disposal drop-off program in Utah County. All other areas may follow the [U.S. Food & Drug Administration](#) guidelines for safe needle disposal. Guidelines suggest placing used needles in a household container such as a laundry detergent or bleach bottle, or a sturdy, opaque plastic container with a screw-top lid. When the container is 3/4 of the way full, seal the lid with duct tape, label "DO NOT RECYCLE" and place container in your regular trash.

- **Water** –Pay attention to the usage on your water bill. Get a good idea of what your average usage is and compare it from month to month! Slow the flow and do not water between 10 am and 6 pm.
- **City Parks** – The safety railings on the bridge are up!!! One more thing completed. Plans are to erect two bowery structures, playground equipment, and rest rooms. Again these are construction areas. We will keep you updated, but encourage you to enjoy the walking path and beautiful view of the area. **PLEASE - PLEASE - PLEASE CLEAN UP AFTER YOUR DOGS!!**



❖ Police

- **WELCOME!** – We want to welcome Officer Nate Jacobsen to the Willard Police Department. He joins the force as a full-time officer. He most recently worked for the Vernal Police Department. We are pleased to have him join the Department.
- **RATTLE SNAKES** – There have been numerous reports of rattle snakes in resident's yards. Please be aware and don't approach them. Contact Box Elder Dispatch to have an officer respond.
- **DOGS** – If you are a dog owner, license your dog, keep them on a leash when walking them, control barking- especially at night and clean up after them if they "do their business" anywhere that is not in your yard!
- **THEFTS AND VEHICLE BURGLARY** – The Police Department continues to get reports of items stolen out of yards and vehicles. Put items away. Lock garages, storage sheds and lock your vehicles. Don't leave purses, bags, electronics, coins, personal information in your vehicle and if you do, don't leave them in plain view. Report suspicious activity when you see it! The number to Box Elder County Dispatch is 435-734-3800 for non-emergency calls. If it is an emergency call 911.
- **DOOR-TO-DOOR SALES** - It's Spring and there are always Door –to-door sales people around. The Box Elder Sheriff's Office issued a warning and the Police Department has received complaints regarding asphalt coatings or resurfacing. Door-to-Door Sales people are required to have a Willard City Business License. It is ok to ask them. If they cannot show you the license call Box Elder County Dispatch at 435-734-3800 and an officer will check them out. Don't pay up front and if you suspect fraud contact the Police immediately.
